From Pastor Amy



Dear friends,

Holy Week is always a special week for me. There's always been something sacred, something holy about journeying with Jesus through the last hours of his

life to the cross. It's when I make this journey with Jesus, as sobering as it is, that the beauty and excitement of the Easter resurrection overflows within me.

On Palm Sunday we wave our palms and cry "Hosanna" remembering Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. On Maundy Thursday we remember Jesus' last supper with his disciples. We hear of his washing the disciples' feet and enacting the new commandment to "love one another as I have loved you". We gather on Good Friday and hear the story of Jesus' passion – his arrest, trial, suffering, and crucifixion. It's a solemn day and the weight of Jesus' death weighs heavy upon us. And then we gather on Easter Sunday to hear and celebrate the great news of Jesus' resurrection – Christ is risen! Alleluia!

But what about Holy Saturday? What do we do with that time between Jesus' death and his resurrection? Think about it. The disciples saw their friend, their Lord, beaten and crucified. They saw his dead body laid in a tomb. They had followed Jesus for over three years. They heard him teach and saw him heal. They walked with him, talked with him,

ate with him, prayed with him. And now he was dead. All their hopes and dreams had been shattered.

Can you imagine what it must have been like to be one of Jesus' followers on that Sabbath Saturday, the day after Jesus died? Can you grab a glimpse of the devastation they must have felt, the state of shock they must have been in? For three days they sat in the depth of death and grief.

This year, I invite you to dwell on the "in between time" of Holy Saturday. Spend some time in silence, in reflection, in prayer as you think about all that has happened in the last days of Jesus' life and the significance of his death. We know that resurrection is coming, but on Holy Saturday give yourself the space to enter into a time of waiting. Don't jump into the joy of resurrection too fast. Give yourself the time to contemplate Jesus' death for then, and only then, will the feast of the resurrection be sweet.
